What is the purpose of this update?

Description of this fund

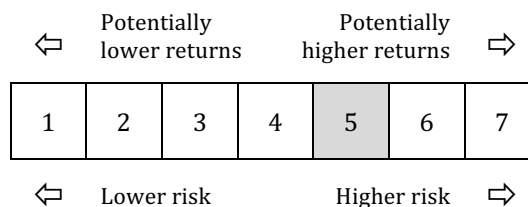
Objective: to provide a total return, before costs and tax, higher than the Russell Global Large Cap - Net Index over the long term (3 years plus).

Strategy: the underlying investment exposure is predominantly to a broad range of international shares listed on stock exchanges in developed markets and emerging international markets. Derivatives may be used to obtain or reduce exposure to securities and markets, to implement investment strategies and to manage risk. The Fund is normally not hedged to the New Zealand dollar.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Russell Investments Global Shares Fund.¹



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

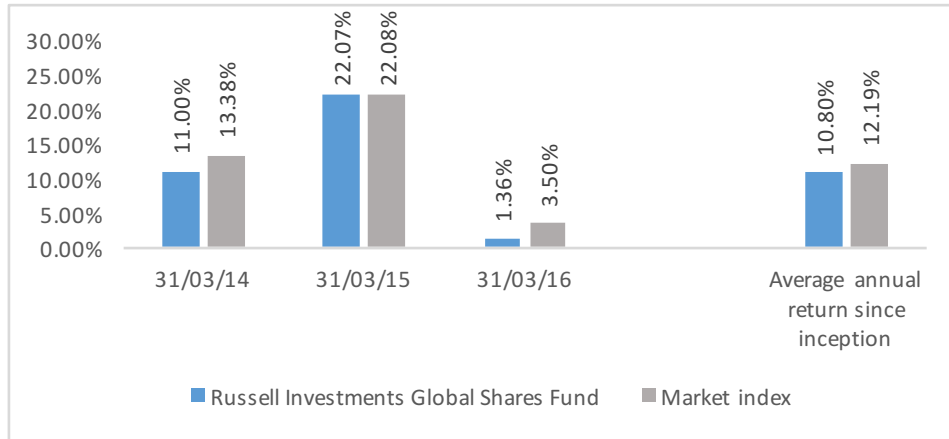

This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 30 September 2016.

What fees are investors charged?

Example of how this applies to an investor

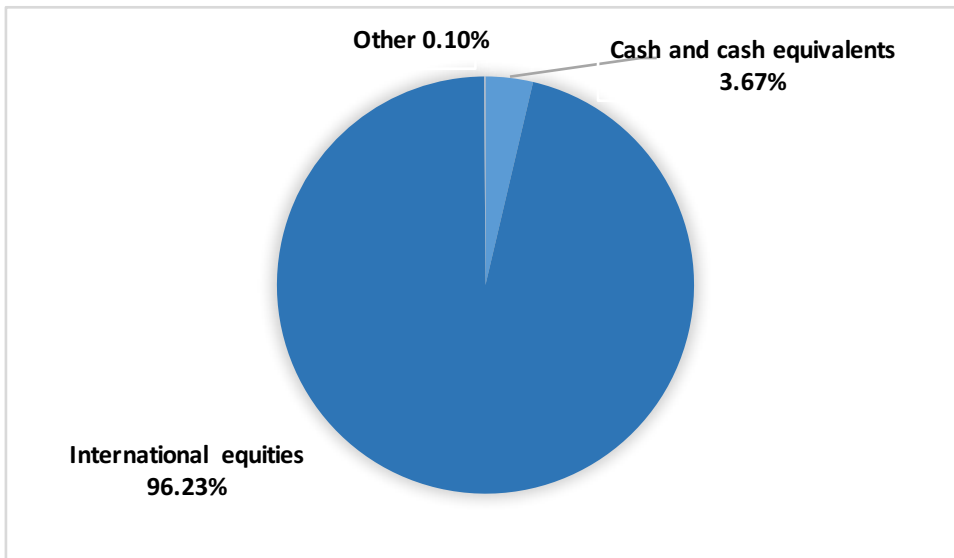
Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Anthony received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$237 (that is 2.37% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a total return after tax of \$136 for the year.

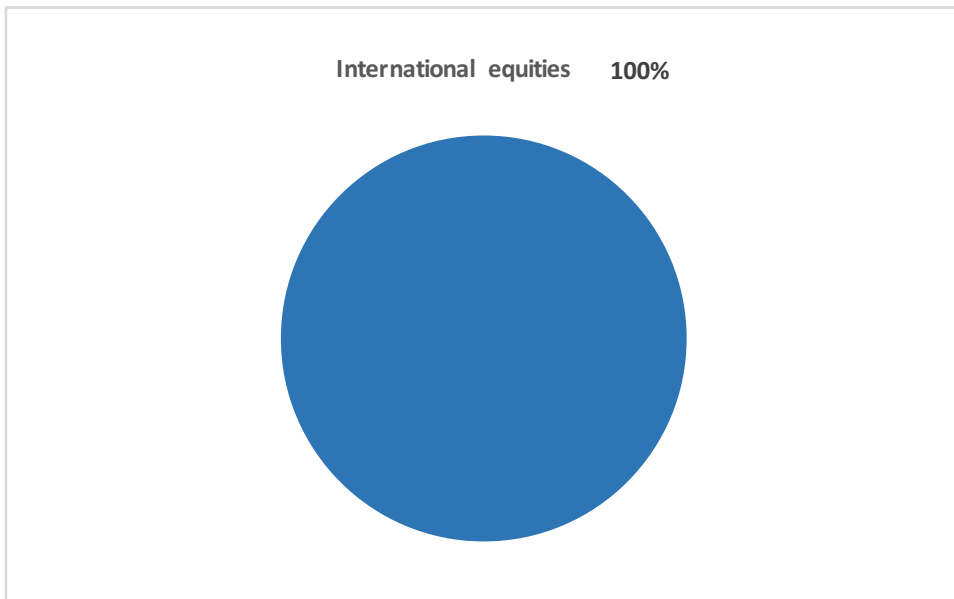
What does the fund invest in?

Notes

¹ A combination of actual Fund returns and market index returns have been used to determine the risk indicator as the Fund has not been operating for the required five years. The risk indicator may therefore provide a less reliable indicator of the Fund's future volatility. Market index returns have been used for the period to 30 November 2012.

² These returns are for the year to 30 September 2016.

³ The bar chart shows fund returns after deducting fees and tax. Tax is deducted at the highest Prescribed Investor Rate of 28%. However, the market index returns are shown before deducting fees and tax.

⁴ We have taken the underlying fund's fees and costs data from the underlying fund's financial statements which are for the year to 30 June 2016. In this fund update, we have estimated the underlying fund's fees and costs for the year to 31 March 2016 on the assumption they will be the same as that disclosed in those financial statements.
